Dr Malan is a Senior Lecturer in Ethics and Governance and Director of the Centre for Corporate Governance in Africa at the University of Stellenbosch Business School in South Africa. His research focus areas are corporate governance, business ethics and corporate responsibility.

He is a member of the following initiatives: the World Economic Forum's Global Agenda Council on Values, the International Corporate Governance Network's Integrated Business Reporting Committee, and the Advisory Committee of the United Nations Principles for Responsible Management Education (PRME). He is also an honorary visiting fellow in the faculty of management at Cass Business School and a portfolio partner at the International Centre for Corporate Governance at the University of St Gallen.

Previously he was an associate director with KPMG Forensic, where he was responsible for ethics and integrity services.

He holds a PhD in Business Administration, a Masters degree in Philosophy as well as a Masters degree in Business Administration (MBA), all from the University of Stellenbosch in South Africa. He is the residential head of Wilgenhof in Stellenbosch, the oldest university men's residence in Africa. In recent years, Prof Malan has taught the modules Sustainable Enterprises on the Postgraduate Diploma in Business Management & Administration and Governance & Ethics on the MPhil in Development Finance programme.
