The Corporate Governance Conference 2022 is jointly hosted by the *Centre for Corporate Governance in Africa* at the Stellenbosch Business School and the *School of Accountancy* at Stellenbosch University. The conference will take place from 12 to 13 December 2022 in beautiful Cape Town, South Africa. The conference is in-person, with a virtual option in exceptional cases. We encourage delegates to attend in person, to allow for enhanced engagement and collaboration.

The conference provides an excellent opportunity for researchers, academics, practitioners and post-graduate students to present their research, share their experience and discuss new and challenging issues in corporate governance.

The keynote speakers are Prof Mervyn King, the Patron of the Good Governance Academy and former Chair of the King Committee on Corporate Governance in South Africa, and Dr Nicky Newton-King, former CEO of the Johannesburg Stock Exchange.
