*The first day will only start late afternoon, with a keynote speaker address and a cocktail function. The second day will be a full day conference.

The Corporate Governance Conference 2022 is jointly hosted by the *Centre for Corporate Governance in Africa* at the Stellenbosch Business School and the *School of Accountancy* at Stellenbosch University. The conference will take place from 12 to 13 December 2022 in beautiful Cape Town, South Africa. The conference is in-person, with a virtual option in exceptional cases. We encourage delegates to attend in person, to allow for enhanced engagement and collaboration.

The conference provides an excellent opportunity for researchers, academics, practitioners and post-graduate students to present their research, share their experience and discuss new and challenging issues in corporate governance.

We invite submissions of full-length papers, as well as work-in-progress papers, on the following themes (but not limited to):

- Corporate citizenship and ethical leadership.
- Board of directors and corporate governance committees (including risk, audit, remuneration and IT governance).
- Integrated reporting, stakeholder engagement, sustainability and integrated thinking.
- New developments within the corporate governance landscape.

The conference is linked to a special issue of the *South African Journal of Business Management*. Subsidy bearing proceedings of the Corporate Governance Conference 2022 will also be published, but only full-length papers qualify. Only full-length papers will be considered for the special issue of the *South African Journal of Business Management*. All full-length (maximum 8 000 words) and work-in-progress (maximum 1 000 words) papers will be subjected to a double-blind peer review process.

Best paper awards for the best full-length paper; the best student paper; and the best work-in-progress paper are respectively sponsored by the South African Institute of Chartered Accountants (SAICA); LexisNexis; and the Centre for Corporate Governance in Africa of the Stellenbosch Business School.

The keynote speakers are Prof Mervyn King, Patron of the Good Governance Academy and former Chair of the King Committee on Corporate Governance in South Africa, and Dr Nicky Newton-King, former CEO of the Johannesburg Stock Exchange.

Work-in-progress papers should also follow the general style guide of the author guidelines, but should not exceed 1 000 words and should at least address the following: Title; Abstract; Keywords (maximum of five); Introduction; Preliminary literature review, research problem and envisaged research methodology; Preliminary findings; and Conclusion and recommendations.
